# 1. Introduction and thanks:

EL introduced the attendees and thanked the growing group of regular volunteers over the last 12 months who have supported the orchard in many ways including: Volunteer Cornwall, Duke of Edinburgh students, weekly working groups, Leach Pottery Volunteers

#### 2. Celebration of Achievements:

EL and SH have collated a list of some of the main achievements over the last 12 months, these include:

- The construction of the clay pizza oven on site: Laurence from the Leach pottery has been very
  involved in the design and build of the clay oven working with community volunteers and local
  children on the construction. This has also been supported by Duwayne Langley who has built a
  protective roof over the top of the oven.
- Planting of over 32 trees in the course of the year
- The planting of the wildflower meadow and wild raspberry bushes to support pollination
- The building of beehives by Duwayne and the introduction of bees into the hives, Duwayne has also attended a bee keeping course to improve his knowledge of this area.
- Clearing the entrance and ongoing maintenance of the land including a huge push to clear the remaining brambles on site.
- The introduction of seasonal events advertised and attended by a wide range of local people including:
- Pizza evenings
- Apple day 2016
- The wassail
- An Easter Egg Hunt
- Foraging walks starting in the Orchard
- The documenting of the plant species on the website
- The production and maintenance of a vibrant website by Elise Langley!
- The launch of the 'Adopt a tree' scheme 7 have been adopted so far
- 3. **St Ives Ladies Darts** team attended to present the group with a generous donation of £240.00, the chairperson expressed her gratitude to the darts team for choosing the Orchard
- 4. **Treasurers report** It was agreed that next year the group will organize the AGM to be held in April so it represents a full financial year's accounts.
